## IWG'S UNIQUE CIRCULATING POTABLE WATER SYSTEM TO BE INSTALLED ON GULFSTREAM G-IV BUSINESS JET

Burnaby, BC, Canada - International Water-Guard Industries Inc. (IWG). is pleased to announce that it has signed a contract with Gulfstream Aerospace Corporation to install IWG's Circulating Potable Water System (*C-PWS™*) on a Gulfstream G-IV business jet aircraft owned by the Detroit Pistons basketball organization. The installation is expected to be complete this summer. No contract price was released.

IWG will meet stringent U.S. Federal Aviation Authority and Transport Canada certification requirements, which will allow the *C-PWS™* to be readily installed on hundreds of other G-IV aircraft currently flying.

"System sales have a meaningful effect on our revenues," said Bill Coote, IWG President and CEO. "More importantly, we now have real-world credibility with the owners and operators of aircraft manufactured by another of the biggest names in corporate aviation."

"We have been an IWG customer for many years, and have been very happy with the performance of the ultraviolet disinfection units on our aircraft," said Dewey Norton, Director of Maintenance for the Detroit Pistons' aircraft. "Because of that experience, we were keen to have IWG's new water system installed on the G-IV we are adding to our fleet."

The *C-PWS™* is a new concept in aircraft potable water systems that continually circulates the water throughout the system, rather than leaving it stagnant in the lines until a faucet or other user device is opened. Among the advantages of the *C-PWS™* design are a much lower installed weight, smaller installation 'footprint', and integral potable water treatment. The system is simple in design, and is therefore reliable and inexpensive to maintain.

The *C-PWS™* is equipped with IWG's NPS-A3 water treatment unit, which combines carbon filtration with ultraviolet disinfection to ensure water that is clean and good-tasting, and free of harmful or even fatal microbiological contaminants. Ultraviolet light in the NPS-A3 destroys bacteria and viruses that may be in the water, including emerging health threats like *e coli*, *cryptosporidium*, *giardia*, and *bacillus anthracis*, the bacteria that causes anthrax.

International Water-Guard Industries Inc. is a Canadian water treatment company providing total water treatment solutions to aviation, industrial/commercial, and residential customers throughout the world. Services include water treatment needs analysis, system design/assembly, and ongoing support. IWG has expertise in all aspects of water treatment, including advanced filtration, ultraviolet disinfection, reverse osmosis, deionization, etc.
