

Production Technician

Reporting to the Production Supervisor, and within a strict Quality Control structure, the duties of the Production Technician shall include:

- Assembling and testing aviation products in accordance with production requirements, specifications, modifications, drawings and procedures. This includes:
 - a. Mechanical assembly;
 - b. Electronic assembly, ideally from board level up;
 - c. Operating power tools and machines, such as a drill press;
 - d. Working at different work stations (i.e., manufacturing, testing, maintenance) as required, and
 - e. Being prepared to receive further in-house training as required.
- Consulting with production supervisor to schedule production runs in a cost and time efficient manner;
- Ensuring production deadlines are maintained and products are shipped on schedule.
- Maintaining records of time and materials, rates of production, and signing off on quality assurance documentation as necessary.
- Such other duties and responsibilities that may be assigned by the Production Supervisor.

The successful candidate will have:

- Experience/Education: A minimum of two to three years related work experience or 6 month trade/technical school diploma (preferably in electronics) or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Language Skills: Verbal and written fluency in English
- Mechanical Skills: High
- Computer Skills: Word processing, spreadsheet experience and Windows are an asset but not mandatory.
- Health: Must be able to stand 6-7 hours per day and lift objects up to 35 kgs. in weight.
