IWG RECEIVES ITS FIRST CIRCULATING POTABLE WATER SYSTEM ORDER FOR A BOEING BUSINESS JET

Burnaby, BC, Canada - International Water-Guard Industries Inc. (IWG) is pleased to announce that it has received an order for its patented Circulating Potable Water System (C-PWS™) from Associated Air Center. The C-PWS™ will be installed as a 'kit' on a Boeing BBJ-2 that will receive an interior completion at Associated's Dallas, Texas facility. The installation will be IWG's first C-PWS™ project for the Boeing BBJ series of aircraft.

The C-PWS™ concept of continual circulation and onboard water treatment results in a light, simple and highly reliable potable water system that resists freezing without electrical line heaters, provides increased performance in all flight profiles, and delivers clean fresh water free of microbial contamination. The BBJ installation will include Super Plastic Formed (SPF) Titanium water tanks. The SPF process allows for very strong, very light tanks that conform to the shape of the aircraft fuselage, and allow them to be placed in previously unused spaces. The IWG tanks will contain twice the water (120 gallons nominal) as the original pressurized water tank, without requiring additional space.

"This is a very significant order for us," said Bill Coote, IWG's President and CEO. "We are of course extremely pleased by this development, especially since we'll be working with a respected BBJ completions specialist like Associated. That also has positive downstream implications for us, since we will have a certified system kit that we can offer to the operators of the 73 other BBJ's that Boeing has delivered."

The BBJ (Boeing Business Jet) was developed from the Boeing 737 NG family of aircraft. More than 2000 737 NG aircraft have been delivered or are on order. The C-PWS™ is applicable to those aircraft as well.
