LARGE ORDER BY BUSINESS JET MANUFACTURER SIGNALS IMPORTANCE OF IWG AVIATION WATER TREATMENT

Burnaby, BC, Canada - International Water-Guard Industries Inc. (IWG) is pleased to announce that it has received an order valued at approximately \$500,000 for its flight certified aircraft potable water treatment units – one of the largest single orders in the company's history. The order was placed by one of IWG's major business jet customers.

The order is for IWG's NPS-A6 water treatment unit, which employs a combination of filtration and ultraviolet disinfection to deliver clean, fresh water free of potentially harmful bacteria and viruses to passengers and crew. Most of the units are slated for delivery by the end of 2005.

"This order is more confirmation of the growing importance of on-board water treatment in the aviation community, and the maturity of our relationship with large aerospace manufacturers" said David Fox, IWG's President and CEO.

Nearly 1000 of IWG's flight-certified water treatment units are flying in corporate, VIP transport, and military transport aircraft worldwide.
