IWG COMMENT REGARDING FORMER ENGAGEMENT OF BADSHAH COMMUNICATIONS GROUP

Burnaby, BC, Canada . Today, the Board and management of International Water-Guard were informed of the temporary suspension of the Badshah Communications Group by the BC Securities Commission. IWG wishes to make a statement regarding the brief engagement of this group earlier in the year.

Last March, we engaged the Badshah Communications Group (BCG) solely to provide investor relations communication and we terminated our relationship with them in October, just six months later, explained David C. Fox, president and CEO. BCG had been contracted to assist us in increasing the company's profile within the investment community. After several months, we felt BCG was not the appropriate fit for our needs and the relationship was terminated.
