IWG PASSES THE 1000 UNIT MILESTONE FOR AIRCRAFT WATER TREATMENT UNITS

Burnaby, BC, Canada - International Water-Guard Industries Inc. is pleased to announce that it has now shipped more than 1000 of its aircraft water treatment units. IWG's four models of ultraviolet water treatment units are installed in business jets, VIP airliner conversions, and military transport aircraft around the world.

"We have seen a significant rise in activity, especially over the past few years," said David Fox, IWG's President and CEO. "This is directly related to a steep increase in awareness about the problem of biological contamination of onboard water supplies," Fox added. "We have the solution to these concerns, so some recent large orders have pushed our sales numbers up over 1000."

IWG's original product, the NPS-A2, was the first flight qualified ultra-violet potable water disinfection unit ever developed. IWG has since expanded its product portfolio to include an array of increasingly sophisticated products. The NPS-A3 is smaller, lighter, and contains advanced monitoring as well as an integral filter module. A derivative, the NPS-A4, is IWG's smallest ultraviolet disinfection unit, and is increasingly being installed as a point of use device in aircraft galleys. IWG's newest, and most advanced unit, the NPS-A6, is a standard factory installation on a number of business jets, and is being looked at by the commercial airline industry as well.

IWG has expertise in all aspects of water treatment, and has the products and know-how to provide high quality water for passengers and crew, and light weight, space saving solutions for the aircraft operator.
